

e Island or Iejima sits a couple of miles out from the Motobu Peninsula on the western side of Okinawa main island and on a clear day can be seen from most of the west coast. After seeing the island and its distinctive shape on the horizon every day for several years we decided to take the ferry out to le and see it close up.

Ferries to le depart from Motobu Port at 9am and 11am and take about 30 minutes. The last return ferry of the day leaves le at 4pm. Having young children, we decided to take the car with us, which meant we had to be at the port about 30 minutes before departure. After arriving in le we found the nearest Konbini and stocked up on food and drinks for the day ahead.

Mount Gusuku, symbol of le, rises up 172m and since the rest of the island is flat it's a spectacular sight! Of course, you can see Mt Gusuku from anywhere on the island so getting to the car park about ten minutes' drive away was easy with the help of a couple of road signs. On foot, it would take maybe 30-40 minutes from the port. The mountain is considered a sacred place or utaki in Okinawan culture and there is a small shrine next to the start of the trail. For the most part getting to the top involves climbing a steep, but thankfully quite short set of stairs. There is a handrail, so although it's physically



demanding it is accessible to most and my children (3 and 5) had no problems at all. The summit of Mt Gusuku is quite rocky but it's possible to walk about and enjoy the spectacular 360-degree views, take photos and sit down to rehydrate and have snacks. We loved it at the top and spent maybe around 15 minutes up there. Back at the car park there are plenty of facilities – souvenir shop, snack bar and toilets.

Other sights we visited around le were the Niya Thiya Cave and the beautiful le Beach – with soft sand, cafes and an impressive beach swing, this place was a real paradise and a perfect way to end our day! For ferry information – https://www.iejima.org.e.qz.hp.transer.com

伊江島と城山

伊江島と城山(ぐすくやま)

伊江島は沖縄本島の西側、本部半島から数キロ離れた場所に位置 し、晴れた日には沖縄本島西海岸の大半の場所から見ることができます。数年前から毎日のように地平線に浮かぶその島とその特徴的な形を見てきた私たちは、フェリーで伊江島に向かいその姿を間近で見ることにしました。

伊江島行きのフェリーは、本部港から午前9時と11時に出港し、所要時間は約30分です。この日最後の帰りのフェリーの伊江港出港時間は午後4時でした。小さな子供がいるので、車を持っていくことにしました。そのため出港時間の30分前には本部港に着いていなければなりませんでした。伊江島に到着してからは、最寄りのコンビニを見つけ、その日の食料や飲み物を買い込みました。

伊江島のシンボルである城山は標高172mあり、島の他の部分は平地なので、その姿は絶景です。もちろん島のどこからでも城山を見ることができるので、車で10分程のところにある城山の駐車場までは、道路標識をたどりながら簡単に到着することができました。徒歩では、伊江港から30~40分程かと思います。城山は沖縄の文化では御嶽(うたき)と呼ばれる聖地とされており、登山道のスタート地点の横には小さな祠があります。山頂に到達するには急な階段を登らなければならない場面がほとんどですが、ありがたいことに、急な階段の距離はかなり短いです。体力的には厳しいですが、手すりがあるので、ほとんどの人が山頂まで到達できます。私の子供(3歳と5歳)は全く問題ありませんでした。城山の山頂はかなりの岩場ですが、歩き回って360度の絶景を楽しんだり、写真を撮ったり、座って水分補給をしたり、軽食を食べたりすることができます。私たちは山頂をとても気に入り、そこで15分程過ごしました。駐車場に戻ると、お土産屋さんや売店、トイレなどの施設が充実しています。

私が訪れた伊江島周辺の他の観光スポットは、ニャティヤ洞窟と美しい伊江ビーチです。伊江ビーチには柔らかい砂の他に、カフェや印象的なビーチブランコなどがあります。この場所は本当にパラダイスで、私たちの一日を締めくくるには最高の場所でした!

As a family, we try to explore Okinawa as much as we can and spending the night away in a hotel is something we love to do. When images of a newly-opened hotel on the edge of the Yanbaru National Park popped up on my social media I knew we had to check it out.

The Yanbaru Hostel, opened in 2019, is located in the small village of Hentona, just off Route 58 and really close to places like Kunigami Forest Park, Okuma Beach and Hiji Falls. Free parking was available just across the quiet street from the hotel entrance.

We were so impressed as we entered the ground-floor reception – the super-stylish social space was kitted out with a pool table, climbing wall and table tennis so the kids were in their element. And as a lover of photography I was happy taking pictures of all the beautiful details. The staff were friendly and efficient and obviously passionate about the hotel being successful.

Our family of four booked into one of the family suites, which included private bathroom, two double beds, mini-fridge and seating area. All was exceptionally clean and comfortable and cost 14,000 yen per night, payable in cash on arrival. Other rooms are available including twins and dormitories. A shared kitchen and dining space were just below us on the second floor and here we could use the basic amenities such as kettle, microwave and various utensils. After further exploring we came across the rooftop terrace, complete with tables and chairs, barbecue and the most incredible 360 degree views!

My overall impression of the Yanbaru Hostel was great; it is well located for exploring the northern parts of Okinawa, good value for money and so aesthetically inspiring I can't wait to go back.

私たち家族は沖縄を探検しホテルに宿泊するのが大好きです。 やんばる国立公園の端に新しくオープンしたホテルの画像が私のSNSに出てきたとき、要チェック!とすぐ思いました。

2019年にオープンしたやんばるホステルは、国道58号線からすぐの辺土名の小さな村にあり、国頭村森林公園、オクマビーチ、比地大滝などの場所からとても近いです。ホテルの入り口から静かな通りの向かいにある無料駐車場に車を止められます。

1階のレセプションに入ったとたんとても感動しました。素晴らしくスタイリッシュな社交スペースには、ビリヤード台、クライミングウォール、卓球台が備え付けられ、子供たちはのびのび楽しんでいました。そして、写真好きの自分としては、美しいと感じる部分を詳細部分まで写真におさめることができて楽しかったです。スタッフはフレンドリーでてきぱきと働いており、ホテルでの仕事に情熱を注いでいるのが明らかに見てとれました。

4人家族の私たちはファミリースイートの1つを予約したのですが、部屋には専用バスルーム、ダブルベッド2台、ミニ冷蔵庫、ソファスペースが備わっていました。すべてが非常に清潔で快適。1泊14,000円で、到着時の現金支払いが可能でした。ツインルームやドミトリーなどの他のタイプの部屋もあります。共用キッチンとダイニングスペースは私たちの宿泊場所のすぐ下の2階にあり、ここではやかんや電子レンジ、色々な調理器具などの基本的な備品を使用することができました。さらにホステル内を見て回ると、テーブルと椅子にバーベキュー、そして最高に素晴らしい360度ビューを見渡せる屋上テラスを発見!

やんばるホステルの全体的な印象は素晴らしかったです。沖縄の北部を探索するのに便利な場所にあり、コスパがよく、アート的な面でも刺激的で、次にまた行けるときまで待ちきれません。

Whale Watching

A Mexican Portuguese restaurant that serves coffee? YES! And it has Omochikaeri- (お持ち帰り) take out service! Located in Ginowan just off of route 58, right behind the big Jimmy's, it is a magnet for Mexican food lovers and coffee enthusiasts alike. The rustic feel of the restaurant is welcoming and creates a barn like but still homey atmosphere.

When I went to Pipeline Coffee with my friends, we were just on the search for coffee on the go, but we found a real gold mine! The menu offered a big coffee selection and we got different kinds of lattes, iced americanos and hot coffees. The taste of the beans was very refreshing, not too bitter but not too sour either. I personally like dark roast and hardly ever go for light roast, but Pipeline's iced americano is just right in the middle to be refreshingly light but strong and smooth, just how I like my espressos.

We ordered outside and waited in the seating area to pay at a "to go" window, which is a great way to accommodate visitors who do not want to enter the restaurant. Pipeline Coffee's menu ranges from filter brewed coffee, french press or pour over to espresso coffees like americanos, lattes and specials like organic honey latte and espresso tonics. Most of the coffees can be ordered hot or cold which is perfect for cover lovers of different brewing methods. Seasonal bread & coffee sets or lunch & coffee sets are available for take out as well.

The prizes range from 350 Yen for a simple Iced or hot brewed coffee to 500 Yen or 600 Yen for espresso lattes. The special organic honey latte uses locally grown Okinawan beans and costs 650 Yen and the espresso club soda tonic which is only an iced option, is definitely worth a try to experience a different kind of coffee, even if you are not a big fan of cider coffees. It truly brings out the character of the roast!

Pipeline is an easy stop, there is plenty of parking for customers behind the building, the staff is very welcoming and not afraid to use their English! Check out their Instagram to be updated on lunch and coffee specials!

パイプラインコーヒー

今回ご紹介するパイプラインコーヒーは、メキシコ料理とポルトガル料理のレストランでコーヒーも楽しめるお店。しかも、お持ち帰りも可能なんです。宜野湾市の国道58号線を降りてすぐ、大きくそびえるJimmy'sのすぐ後ろにあり、メキシコ料理が好きな人やコーヒーの愛好家たちが集まるお店です。素朴でフレンドリーな雰囲気のレストランで、納屋のように見えながらもアットホームな雰囲気を醸し出しています。

最初は外出先で友人とコーヒーを探していただけだったんですが、幸運にもこのとんでもない隠れ家レストランを発見しちゃったんです!コーヒーのメニューは豊富で、私たちは様々な種類のラテ、アイス・アメリカーノ、ホットコーヒーをいただきました。豆の味は、酸っぱすぎず苦すぎない、とても爽やかな口当たりでした。個人的には深煎りが好きで浅煎りはほとんど飲まないのですが、パイプラインのアイス・アメリカーノはちょうどその中間にくる味。驚くほどライトながら、濃くて滑らかで、まさに自分好みのエスプレッソの味でした。

私たちは外で注文し、客席エリアで待ってテイクアウト用の窓口で支払いをしたんですが、この方式なら店内に入りたくない人にも便利。パイプラインコーヒーのメニューには、バッチブリュー、フレンチプレス、ハンドドリップなどのフィルターコーヒーから、アメリカーノやラテなどのエスプレッソコーヒー、そしてオーガニックハニーラテやエスプレッソトニックといったスペシャルメニューまで、コーヒーの種類が豊富に揃っています。そのほとんどがホットかアイスで注文できますので、様々な淹れ方を試すのが好きな方もきっと大満足できます。季節限定のパン&コーヒーセットやランチ&コーヒーセットもあり、これらのメニューもお持ち帰りできます。

お値段は、シンプルなアイスやホットコーヒーの350円から始まり、エスプレッソやラテの500~600円までとなっています。地元沖縄産の豆を使った特製オーガニックハニーラテは650円、アイスのみのエスプレッソクラブソーダトニックは、一味違ったコーヒーを楽しみたいという方に大変お勧めのコーヒーです。コーヒーソーダが苦手な方でも、一度試してみる価値あり。ローストの個性がよく引き出されたコーヒーです。

パイプラインコーヒーは車での来店も便利。建物の裏手には来客用駐車スペースがたくさん用意されています。スタッフはとてもフレンドリー!お店のインスタグラムもチェックしてみてください。ランチやコーヒーのスペシャルや日替わりメニューなど、最新情報が得られます。

American Sizes Cheap Prices Will Travel to Northern Bases

Just how important is rice in Japanese restaurants? Considering that most restaurants have replaced their hamburger buns with rice, well, I would say it's pretty darn important. I mean what's next? Continental breakfast rice bowls? Doesn't sound very appealing but that would be interesting. Gokoku restaurant understands this well and has put extra emphasis on their rice by truly showcasing it as the star of their dishes.

Gokoku at first glance seems like a typical restaurant until you get served your rice. Rice is served in a mini pork bun steamer looking container with an inner metal coating inside. The rice is at about 80% cooked when served on the table and are given strict instructions on how to cook it the remaining 20%. This is some real serious stuff. I mean, they even give you an hour glass to measure. Obviously, the taste is as expected, sublime. You know good rice when you can eat it as is without any viand. They also have a range of different types of rice such as the ju-go-kokumai which is a Japanese style rice mix which they include different types of grains and sometimes red beans. As for the viand, they have the standard tonkatsu, karaage, tempura, saba-miso, ox tongue, etc. all good stuff. I recommend the Katsu with the demi-glace sauce which is actually interesting because most of the times in Japanese restaurants, they pair katsu with tonkatsu sauce or curry. They also have a good selection on desserts but nothing to really fuss about. Just typical good Japanese desserts. In terms of pricing, I would say it is a little bit on the above average side but understandable as this restaurant serves quality over quantity. Each dish will set you back about 1,000+ yen.

Overall, Gokoku seems fitting for all types of diners such as a family dinner out option, lunch with co-workers, friends, and most definitely date night. The restaurant is situated conveniently on the window side of the 4th floor of the AEON Rycom mall giving it a nice modest view. They currently only have one branch in Okinawa. To get there, simply head to the AEON Rycom mall. Gokoku is located on the 4th floor close to the Cinemas.



「五穀」は、ご飯が出てくるまでは一見普通のレストランのように見えます。ご飯は、小さなお釜に入った状態で出されます。テーブルに運ばれたご飯は約8割まで炊きあがっていて、残りの2割をどのように炊くか厳しい指示があります。これはなかなか本格的。砂時計まで渡されるのですから。そして、その味は期待通り、最高です。おかず無しでご飯だけで食べられることで、美味しいご飯だとわかります。また、十五穀米という様々な種類の穀物や小豆が入っている混ぜご飯もあります。おかずはというと、定番のとんかつ、唐揚げ、天ぷら、鯖の味噌煮、牛タンなどがありますがどれも美味。私のお薦めは、デミグラスソースを添えたカツです。日本のレストランでは、カツにとんかつソースを添えたり、カレーを合わせたりすることが多いので、面白いと思います。デザートも充実していますが、典型的な日本のデザートです。価格面は、平均より少し高いと思いますが、このレストランは量より質を重視しているので、納得できます。1品の価格は1,000円台です。

「五穀」は、あらゆるタイプの食事に利用できるでしょう。家族でのディナー、会社の同僚や友人とのランチ、そして夜のデートにはぴったりです。お店はイオンライコムモールの4階窓側にあり、眺めも良くて便利です。沖縄には、現在1店舗しかありません。お店への行き方は、イオンライコムモールに向かうだけ。「五穀」は4階の映画館のすぐ近くにあります。


