

MM Kariyushi Aquarium, Okinawa's second-largest aquarium was opened in May 2020 and we've already been multiple times. It's located on the second floor of the newly-opened lias Okinawa Toyosaki Mall in Tomigusuku, just 20 minutes drive south of Naha Airport. It was described as a new kind of aquarium; a combination of animal exhibits and immersive art installations to stimulate the senses and give a unique experience. Tickets can be bought online (valid for 180 days), at convenience stores or at the entrance and cost 2,400 yen for adults (18+), 2000 for youths (13-17) and 1,500 for children (4-12). Children under 3 can enter for free.

As you enter you're advised to download and refer to the official app for information on all of the displays as there are no descriptions in the aquarium. Personally, I prefer to put my phone away at places like this and enjoy a 'screen-free' time so although we didn't learn anything about the animals we saw, we enjoyed it nonetheless. Some of our favourite exhibits included the jelly fish room, the penguins, the sloths and definitely the shark-containing touch pools! There are some other great exhibits such as the fish tank tunnel and the many corals on display. You might feel as though the

facilities are somewhat hidden on your first trip but there are bathrooms, elevators, stairs and a baby room available and there are plenty of staff members to point you in the right direction if you struggle to find them. There is a cafe on the first floor and a gift shop selling items like stuffed animals, cookies and other souvenirs.

Despite a couple of little niggles such as the lack of information unless you use the app, we have had a couple of really enjoyable trips to this aquarium and would defiantly recommend giving it a go!

DMMかりゆし水族館

DMMかりゆし水族館は、2020年5月にオープンした沖縄で2番目の水族館ですが、私はもうすでに何度も行っています! 豊見城市にあるイーアス沖縄豊崎ショッピングモールの2階にあり、那覇空港から車で20分とアクセスも抜群です。館内は、生き物たちの展示と、別世界に迷い込んだかのようなアート感あふれる見せ方の組み合わせで、感覚を刺激するここにしかない体験ができます。

チケットはオンライン (180日間有効)、コンビニや現地で直接購入が可能で、大人 (18歳以上) は2,400円、中人 (13~17歳) は2,000円、小人 (4~12歳) は1,500円、3 歳以下の子供は無料で入場できます。

入館するとまず、公式アプリをダウンロードするように言われ、展示についての情報は全てアプリを参照するように言われます。というのも、水族館の中には説明が何もないのです。個人的に、こういう場所へ来たらスマホはカバンにしまっておいて、「スクリーンフリー」の時間を楽しみたい派なので今回もそうしましたが、生き物について何もわからなくても十分楽しめました。お気に入りはクラゲの部屋、ペンギンたち、ナマケモノ、そしてサメのいるタッチプールです!他にも、海中トンネルやサンゴの展示もありました。初めて行くと施設がわかりにくいかもしれませんが、トイレやエレベーター、階段、授乳室などもあり、わからなければたくさんいるスタッフが親切に教えてくれます。1階にはカフェ、そしてぬいぐるみクッキーなどを販売しているお土産屋さんもあります。

アプリを使わないと情報が閲覧できないと言った小さな不満はありますが、数回訪れていますがとても楽しい場所です。是非、行ってみてください、おススメ!

One thing for certain here in Okinawa is that the people sure love to drink! It is no wonder that Izakaya's (Japanese resto-bars) are so competitive that each one feels the need to one-up the other with a unique edge just to stay relevant. Among them, Ikesu No Ginji, decided to go big or go home with one of the most unique themes I have ever seen. Let's "sail" in to it and you will see what I mean.

Located in Awase where the fishing ports are so close by, it's only natural to capitalize on your surroundings. Ikesu No Ginji has decorated the entire restaurant to this exact theme. They got buoys with fishing nets, fish tanks, and boat shaped seating. Aye, captain you heard me... Tonight, we dine on the helm! For the food, bring on the sea. They got clams, squid, octopus, fish batayaki (butter fried), salt grilled, tempura fried, sashimi style, and many more. Pretty much if you can think it, most likely they will have it. I ordered the chicken... (Yes, my wife

was furious!) Honestly, it wasn't bad. Obviously though, I recommend the seafood.

The clam soup appetizer was a scrumptious flavour combo of both ocean-y and earthy. Not sure if you can picture that flavour description but the point is that it was good and calming. The price is what you would expect for a typical izakaya ranging at about 2,000 to 3,000 yen each. They do have happy hour specials so you might want to capitalize on those times to save a few bucks.



Just in case it wasn't apparent by now, it is an izakaya after all so probably best to avoid for families with kids. Weekend chill session for the boys however is good to go all the way! Officemate farewell parties works too. To get there, head north on Awase bay street. When you pass the Okinawa athletics park west entrance, start looking to your right. It'll be next to a Shell gas station. If you reach the Domino's on your right, you've gone too far.

生け簀の銀次

沖縄に来てつくづく思うのは、沖縄の人はお酒が大好き! そのためか居酒屋の競争は激しく、何かひとつでも売りになるようなポイントがないと生き残っていけません。その中でも、今回紹介する「生け簀の銀次」はひとつのユニークなテーマをとことんまで突き詰めた居酒屋だと言えます。それでは、その世界に「漕ぎ出して」みましょう。

泡瀬の漁港近くに位置しているため、その環境を存分に活かすのは自然なことでしょう。生け簀の銀次店内には、漁をする網やブイ、水槽、そして座席も漁船のような形になっており、店内全てを漁港や漁師のイメージで装飾しています。アサリ、イカ、タコ、魚のバター焼き、塩焼き、天ぷら、刺身などなど、思いつく魚介類が全部あるというほどまだたくさんあります。ちなみに私はチキンを注文しました…(もちろん妻にめちゃめちゃ怒られましたが笑)いや、美味しかったですよ!でもやはりおススメは魚介類です。

あさりの汁物は、海と大地の風味がよいマッチングで美味でした。例えがわかりにくいかもしれませんが、美味しいと同時に落ち着くような感じです。価格帯としては2,000円から3,000円と、通常の居酒屋の相場と同じくらい。ハッピーアワーもやっているので、早く行けば少しお得になります。

ここまで読んでいただければわかると思いますが、やはり居酒屋なので子供連れのご家族は避けた方が無難かも。週末に女子会ならぬ男子会にはもってこい、閉店まで行っちゃってください!職場の歓送迎会に使うのもアリです。

"Cap on cap?"

This is what I grossly misheard the cashier say as I paid for my order at Jai Thai. Later, I found out she was actually saying "Khaawp khun kha" which basically means thank you. I guess that makes more sense rather than my initial thought of her commenting on my hair style (which looks like a cap, perhaps?) Besides the point, let's put a pin on that for now and get into what really matters – the menu.

For as long as I can remember, there was a time when Jai Thai was seemingly the only place to get Thai food on the island. Recently, their competitors have been catching up but Jai Thai seems to be doing okay and is keeping its footing just fine. They have a lot of the traditional Thai dishes such as the Tom Yan (wife's favourite) and the Phat Thai (my favourite), deep fried spring rolls, Gai Yang chicken, curries, and salads. Speaking of salads, I should mention that they have a whole section dedicated to vegetarians so jackpot for those on a strict weight watching program (It's about time I mention something other than meat). For desserts they have a few options such as a Khanom Charn (a sort of jelly cake) which I feel was just okay.

Rather than any of that, my climactic moment came when I saw their glorious delicious selection of imported beer! (So, sue me, I like beer!) Obviously, they have the Thai favourites such as the Singha and Chang, but also have Singapore's Tiger and Indonesia's Bintang. Oh, how I wish I could just sit there all day and sample them all one by one... thrice over.

Bottomline, despite all those other Thai restaurant options out there, I still consider Jai Thai the go-to place for awesome Thai food. Good menu, clean atmosphere, and fast service. What more could you ask for? I recommend for families, social gatherings, and believe it or not, date night. For date night, I recommend the other branch located in Chatan as it has a spectacular view of the ferris wheel. Jai Thai has 2 branches on island: one is located in the Rycom food court which is what is showcased here, and the other is at Chatan with the view. Whichever you choose, no worries as food will be spectacular just the same. If you get the chance, make sure to greet the staff with a little "Khaawp khun khap" as well. I bet it'll just make their day!

私の記憶では、以前は沖縄でタイ料理が食べたい時ジャイタイで しか食べられない、と言った時代がありました。近年、競争相手 も増えてきたようですが、ジャイタイは変わらず好調でしっかりと顧客を掴んで いるようです。

メニューは、トムヤン(妻のお気に入りです)やパッタイ(私のイチオシ)、揚げ春巻き、ガイヤーンチキン、カレー、サラダなど、伝統的なタイ料理を各種取り揃えています。サラダもそうですが、ここにはベジタリアンの人向けのカテゴリも設けられており、体重や体形を気にする人にはこちらがおススメです(肉以外の話もしておかないとね)。デザートには、カノムチャーン(Khanom Charn、ゼリーのようなもの)があり、まあまあかな、と言った感じ。

美味しい料理やデザートはもちろんですが、いちばんテンションが上がるのはずらりと並んだ輸入ビール!シンハービールやチャーンビールのようなタイのビールに加え、シンガポールのタイガービールやインドネシアのビンタンビールまで。一日中、お店の前に座って1種類ずつ飲み比べしたいな~。

結局のところ、近年タイ料理レストランは増えてきていますが、美味しいタイ料理が食べたいならやっぱりジャイタイがお勧め、ということ。メニューが豊富、清潔な雰囲気、そしてサービスが早い。これ以上何か必要?家族連れや職場の集まりなどにもよいですが、実はデートにもお勧めです。デートに行くなら北谷店に行くべし。観覧車を眺めながら食事を楽しむことができます。県内には2店舗あり、ひとつは今回画像でもご紹介しているライカムショッピングモールのフードコート内、もうひとつは景色を楽しみながら食事ができる北谷店です。どちらへ行ってもお食事は同じくらい素晴らしいのでご安心を。

'Cause I-I-I'm hungry for some Bulgogi tonight. With the success in movies and music lately, Korean hype is on an all-time high. It's time to match it up with some good awesome Korean food from Lee's Kitchen and light this baby up like Dynamite!

Before getting in to the food, first of all, service is fast! Usually when it comes to Korean food, I expect to wait awhile for my order to be ready. But at Lee's Kitchen, wait time was surprisingly minimal. I know that might not be too important for some but for people like me with only 45 minutes lunch breaks, it's an absolute godsend. For the food, I had the Bulgogi (Shocker! The meat guy strikes again!) It was an absolute delicious juicy explosion. They had a sauce that is not your typical yakiniku sauce but rather more viscous like soy sauce. Despite my best efforts to ignore, I must admit that they have a pretty awesome Ssam (lettuce wrap) and vegetable selection.

The Ssam actually pairs better with the meats than the rice which leaves you with a lighter feeling. Honestly, I prefer any food that you can gobble up like a spring roll and eat with your hands (probably because it makes me feel like a monkey eating a peeled banana). They also have a good selection of Bibimbap dishes, Sundubu, and Ssam Baps. Boy... I hope you are ready for some rich spice flavours. Also, make sure to leave some room for the Dalgona coffee. It's a dessert-like drink which is simple but effective and gets the job done. Another great thing about Lee's Kitchen is that you can pretty much sit anywhere or order out one of their to-go boxes in case you are in a real rush.

As for the price, it's around mid-range at about 1000 yen plus per set menu. I suppose you can get one of the bowls for a little less at 800 yen but personally for me (Male in his 30's) the quantity doesn't seem enough. Lee's Kitchen is perfect for business lunches, after movie dinner with friends/families, and oddly, date night works too.

Lee's Kitchen in located in the 3rd floor of the Rycom mall food court. Keep your eyes peeled for that bright green lit sign makes it very easy to spot!

食事を見ていく前に、まずサービスから。これがなんと早い!韓国料理と言えば、私は注文した料理が来るまで待つんだろうな〜というイメージがありましたが、Lee's Kitchenでは待ち時間は驚くほど短い。待ち時間なんて気にしない〜という人もいるかもしれませんが、職場のお昼休憩が45分しかない私にはとっても重要ポイント!

料理についても、私はプルコギを食べたのですがめちゃめちゃジューシーで美味しい!通常のソースとはまた違う、とろみのあるソースがたまりません。また、ッサム(レタス包み)や野菜料理のバラエティも豊富です。

ッサム(包んで食べるもの、の意)は、ご飯よりもお肉を包んで食べるとさっぱりとして相性抜群。個人的には、春巻きのように一気に手で食べられる料理が大好きなんです。他にもビビンパやスンドゥブ、サムパップなどもあり、さらにはダルゴナコーヒーまで。ダルゴナコーヒーとはデザートのような飲み物で、シンプルですが美味しく、締めにはピッタリ。お腹にスペースを残しておいてくださいね。Lee's Kitchenのもうひとついいところは、好きな席に座って食事を楽しんでもよし、急いでいる時にはお持ち帰りにするのもよし、なところ。


